

## SUMMARY OF ENHANCEMENTS

The following is a partial listing of enhancements and corrections made to Inquest in version 5.3.3 available November 17, 2009.

NOTE: Equipment added with a Windows Mobile handheld can no longer be downloaded to a Palm OS handheld. If you are using both types of handhelds you will need to switch entirely to Windows Mobile units.

<b>1. MOBILE COMPUTING</b>
<b>A. Windows Mobile – Equipment List Status Column</b> The equipment inspection status is refreshed in the equipment list window when a new inspection status is selected.
<b>B. Windows Mobile – CAB file updates</b> Once 5.3.3 is installed supporting library CAB files will be downloaded upon synchronization when required.
<b>C. Windows Mobile – Intermec Handheld/Scanner</b> Intermec handhelds are now fully supported including built in camera.
<b>D. Windows Mobile – Invoice/Work Order Printing</b> Multiple page invoice/work order printing is now supported.
<b>E. Windows Mobile – Deficiency Status</b> A new deficiency status of 'Quoted' has been added.
<b>2. ACCOUNTING INTEGRATION</b>
<b>A. Batch Invoice – Work Order Selection</b> Batch invoicing of work order for a 'Billing Address' has been enhanced. When submitting the batch invoice you will be presented with a list of work orders that can be included. By checking/unchecking the appropriate check boxes you can select the work orders to include.
<b>B. Batch Invoice – Location Identification</b> Option has been included to identify a work order being invoiced by the company name, address, or both.
<b>C. Price List</b> When importing an item to be included on the handheld price list. The bar code field will now be properly defaulted. Resetting the bar code fields to the default values by clicking the update button has also been corrected.
